Last year (2022 - 2023) ... School Goals, School Plan -

Sullivan continues to be a Ministry Targeted school, hence the support we are receiving from Jeanette and the Literacy Lead teacher already mentioned.

Our focus will continue to be on **Small Group Instruction** across Literacy and Numeracy along with an explicit focus on **Descriptive Feedback**, which you are all doing already. As well as continuing to focus on **Classroom Climate and Instruction**, which came from the data on the Equity Continuum Survey from last year,

In addition, specifically in Mathematics, we will focus on... (from Focusing on the Fundamentals of Math)

- **-Developing mental math skills**: doing calculations in the mind, with little or no use of paper and pencil or calculator
- -Developing proficiency with operations: performing calculations with ease, precision, and consistency and with a general understanding of number and operations, number properties, and their appropriate application in problem solving
- -Problem Solving

School Goals for this school year (2023-2024) ... Rea attended Board Learning Symposium on November 3, 2023, and with Catholic School Learning Team and Staff input we developed our Catholic School Improvement Learning Cycle (CSILC). Math continues to be a major focus.... see attached...

Results from last year are in and individual student reports have been sent home to families of grade 3 and 6.

EQAO Principal Meeting...

Some EQAO Research on Math Skills...

- -While student achievement across skill categories is highly correlated, Application is the skill that is critical across all grades.
- -This skill represents the largest proportion of skill items on the primary, junior, and Grade 9 EQAO math assessments

Some EQAO Research on Math Strands...

- -Although learning across the mathematics strands is interconnected, specific strands were highly associated with achieving curriculum expectation, as measured by EQAO in each of the three assessment years:
- -Number is the strand that is most critical in Grade 3 and is foundational across all grades
- -Number and Algebra are both key to meeting curriculum expectations in Grade 6
- -Algebra is most critical to success in Grade 9

Also...

- -Application is the critical skill to achieve level 3 or 4
- -All strands and skills are correlated to one another
