- CCAT Testing on October 24, 2023, for grade 4's for Gifted screening.

The grade 4 students will be administered the Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test. The results of this test are used to identify students who may be eligible for academic challenge programming. These tests will be conducted in the school. It is helpful that students are present during this time, so, it is best not to schedule appointments during this time.

EQAO Assessments Reminder:

The grade 3 and 6 EQAO assessments measure how well students have met the expectations in the Ontario Curriculum. The assessments test what students know and how well they apply their knowledge and skills in reading, writing and mathematics. Students are required to read and respond to passages, to write and to solve mathematical problems. The results are reported in terms of achievement from levels 1– 4 with level 3 as the standard. The window for EQAO assessments of all grades 3 and 6 students has been established for **May 8 to June 12, 2024**. Please keep this important time frame in mind when you are planning family trips or appointments. It is important that all grade 3 and 6 students be in attendance for the assessments.

-Upcoming/Goals...Front second door wheelchair access, Trees on field along perimeter, exterior sign delayed by Board permit (wiring is ready, just waiting for City of Brampton permit), Artwork on gym mats along stage (Santos), Kindergarten playground upkeep work coming.

Kinder grounds work coming...

- Remove logs around the sandbox and replace with double-stacked 6x6" PT posts, and a 2x8" PT cap
 piece screwed on top. Wood to be light sanded to provide a smooth surface, free of cracks and splinters,
 with miter, tight joints. Posts to be secured with 600mm doweled 15-M rebars, at 1m O.C. Ensure final
 height of border is max 11" from finished adjacent surface. **Shape to be approximately SQUARE **Keep
 ramp
 - 2. Remove and dispose of all landscape plastic edging
 - 3. Remove weeds and mulch. Supply and install WOOD CHIPS where required (in place of mulch).
 - 4. Paving
- -A/C for Gym was denied again from Board in early September...Board said no Ministry money for it. An issue in many schools. Reminder, last year we were advised by the Board that our school meets the minimum requirement for A/C.
