So, for grades 4-8, we set aside <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 30</u> to complete the census in class.

DPCDSB Student Census

This November and December, the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) will be running its DPCDSB Student Census. This census is an online survey that collects information about students' social identities associated with the protected grounds of the *Ontario Human Rights Code*, as well as information about students' lived experiences at DPCDSB schools. Collection of identity-based data helps DPCDSB identify disproportionalities and disparities, which are signs of systemic racism and discrimination. Addressing systemic racism and discrimination aligns with Catholic Social Teachings of human dignity, solidarity, living in community, and rights and responsibilities.

The DPCDSB Student Census will be open from November 22, 2021, until December 31, 2021.
