CCCAT Testing

Grade 4 students will be administered the Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test. The results of this test are used to identify students who may be eligible for academic challenge

programming. These tests will be conducted in the school. It is helpful that students are present during these dates, so, it is best not to schedule appointments during this time.

There will be an opportunity for remote learners to write the CCAT test in spring 2021. Information to support the spring testing will be distributed in the new year

- Coats for Kids Project 2020 @ Sullivan - names and sizes due to Ms. Rea



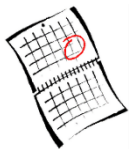
